Who is eligible to submit:

All current members of the Traffic Squad, in good standing for two consecutive years, with eligible family members are welcome to submit an application. This Scholarship includes all Levels of Agents, Supervisors and Managers, as well as other civilian titles.

Applicants must be students in their final year of high school having adequate grades to be accepted to collage. Additionally, this year eligibility includes first year college students. If selected, prior to receiving any scholarship funds, a paid copy of a bursars receipt must be submitted to the TSBA's Treasurer. Additionally, proof of applicant's status as a dependent child of member will be required.

Applications Must be Post Marked no later than March 31st 2010. All qualified applications will be entered in a drawing to be conducted during the month of April and presentations will be made in June with monetary Awards being presented upon receipt of required documentation. Unless otherwise proven ineligible, any disputes not provided for in this document will be the decision of the TSBA Board; all board decisions will be final.

Dependent children, for the purposes of this scholarship, include actual children of a member (as defined by law) or any children who the member is the legal guardian, adopted or otherwise.
